Reading Curriculum/grant Stephanie Korb:

- Stephanie proposing new curriculum school wide
- Grant will cover first 3 years of supplies, consumables, and professional development
- New programs: Super kids K-2, Wonders 3-6, Really Great Reading RTI & Sped, Language Explanation 7-12
- New curriculum includes phonic and phonemic awareness which is currently not in our program, current curriculum 8 years old, going to be replaced anyways, no new burden on district
- New program approved by the state as one of the acceptable reading programs
- Tim moves to recommend Super Kids, Wonders, Intervention program, Language Explanation, and Really Great Reading. Kari Seconds, Unanimous vote for

Community Questions received by email: Concerns about current graduation/completion rates for Cripple Creek compared to other districts

- Graduation rate for 4, 5, and 6 year seniors, completion rates for students who age out, go to a trade or alternative school, or get their GED at an approved program
- If CDE can't track down students who leave the district they are counted as drop outs for the district they were last at.
- State number aren't representative of what is actually happening at Cripple Creek
- Can we look at students who went K-12 at Cripple Creek? Yes, "Lucky 13" are students who have gone all the way through. Check on how these students perform
- What can we publish about ourselves?
Les mentioned plan for concurrent enrollment, he hopes students will graduate with 18-24 college credits with new program
Tory mentioned sending out a brochure for our district
