<p><b>STRENGTHS:</b> We are finding ways to team up on creating learning objectives, but also exploring ways to differentiate the expectations for those objectives to meet the needs within our own classrooms.</p>	<p><b>STRENGTHS:</b> The process is becoming familiar enough to create a desire to implement it in other lessons. We are comfortable with running our own PLC with guidance.</p>	<p><b>STRENGTHS:</b> The process is becoming more data-rich and the conversations are becoming more granular and directed toward specific struggles within each classroom.</p>	<p><b>STRENGTHS:</b> The communication among teachers is improving weekly. You can see a real gelling of these groups.</p>
<p><b>GOALS:</b> *Differentiate objectives to reflect the formative data revealing achievement levels for each classroom.  *Ensure that objectives are created before the assessments.  *Increase the use use of academic language through dialogue with students (Think: Bloom's verbs, and content rich vocabulary).</p>	<p><b>GOALS:</b> * Expand what we are learning through literacy into other lessons. Continue to work toward bringing the Learning Agenda into lesson planning format.  *Get creative with making assessments more manageable (i.e. instead of assessing the entire class with a page long writing assignment, assess 4 students a day with a one page assignment, or assess the entire class with a one paragraph assignments that is focused on a specific skill such as topic sentence.)</p>	<p><b>GOALS:</b> I would like to see a more focused approach to individualized student work when discussing data. (i.e. 12/17 students were able to complete percentages exercise exit ticket.)</p>	<p><b>GOALS:</b> I would like to see a deeper trust develop with regard to providing feedback. I am seeing teachers helping one another, and this is great. Let's push our limits and foster that fail-positive environment where we elicit feedback from one another that is open, honest, and respectful to stretch the limits of our practice!</p>
