<p><b>GOALS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Make sure that objectives are identified first, and assessments are chosen second versus the other way around. Ensure that objectives align to a Colorado State Standard.</li> <li>*Differentiate objectives to reflect the formative data revealing achievement levels for each classroom.</li> <li>*Ensure that objectives are created before the assessments.</li> <li>*Increase the use use of academic language through dialogue with students (Think: Bloom's verbs, and content rich vocabulary).</li> </ul>	<p><b>GOALS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Keeping high expectations will increase student output... If we want three paragraphs, require five.</li> <li>* Expand what we are learning through literacy into other lessons. Continue to work toward bringing the Learning Agenda into lesson planning format.</li> <li>*Get creative with making assessments more manageable (i.e. instead of assessing the entire class with a page long writing assignment, assess 4 students a day with a one page assignment, or assess the entire class with a one paragraph assignments that is focused on a specific skill such as topic sentence.)</li> </ul>	<p><b>GOALS:</b></p> <p>As we become more focused on our data let's begin to explore methods to elevate the students who might not be meeting expectations. To drive growth.</p>	<p><b>GOALS:</b></p> <p>I would like to focus this week on ways in which we can begin to create safe spaces within our classrooms by having courageous conversations with our students when outlining expectations.</p>
